

Other useful Info/Tips:

- Remember to put the lid on your trashcan when you set your trashcan on the curb for pick-up.
- Caution young people and discourage them from playing in the streets and driveways.
- Indeed, it takes a village - get involved if you see a child behaving in an unsafe manner.
- Remind the youth that the streets are not basketball courts, and that they are expected to stop the play, and immediately move out of the street when cars approach.
- Be sure your children do not play in, or deposit their play equipment (bikes, balls, etc.) on the lawns or driveways of neighbors.
- Streets are not social venues for adults, teens, or anyone - move the conversation to a safe place. We, along with our family and friends must remember to drive slowly in the development and watch out for our children.
- Throwing a party? Alert the neighbor that you are going to have an event - they will appreciate your thoughtfulness, and are less likely to become annoyed (with the traffic and noise) if you inform them.
- If you have trash or bulk items to dispose of, do not use the community grounds for dumping. Go to the landfill or call bulk trash pick-up for service.
- Going out of town? Let a neighbor you trust pick up your newspaper and solicitations from your front door and driveway. Ask them to keep a watch on your home.
- Dogs should be leashed when they are being walked. Keep them out of the yards of neighbors, and use a "pooper scooper" to clean up any pet solid waste materials.
